Updates:

- The 18 hole players will begin with a 1pm shotgun start. Registration will open at 11:45am, please do not arrive earlier than that, as the course will be booked for member play. Upon arrival, please sign in at the registration tent (Callaway), where all details will be given for the day.
- The 9 hole players will begin at approximately 3:15pm shotgun; and be placed in the 18 hole groups.
- Draw for the event will be published on www.pjgtour.com, Twitter and Facebook on Thursday May 18th
- When finished, we will all sit for a BBQ supper and ice cream social; all kids will receive a meal as part of the tournament package, adults will only eat if they have confirmed with me.
- Depending on timing of the event, award presentations could begin during the dinner or dessert
- Upon arrival, players can leave clubs in the drop zone and then park the car.
